The Oral History Project believes that all viewpoints need to be included in the historical record of the war and that all opinions must be respected. The Oral History Project encourages all who conduct an interview with us to speak openly about their experiences.

The Oral History Project wants to make sure that everyone who is part of the interview process at the Archive of Modern American Warfare is made aware of and understands the following:

1. By participating in an oral history interview with the Oral History Project, participants are consenting to donate all forms of the interview to the Archive of Modern American Warfare.
2. Participants should be aware that any and all liabilities to which they expose themselves in the course of the interview will be their own and not those of the AMAW Project (to include the Vietnam Center and the Vietnam Archive), Texas Tech University, the State of Texas, and/or any of its employees.
3. We will be glad to discuss with you "off the record" any incident about which you may have questions. However, employees of the Archive of Modern American Warfare, including the staff of the Oral History Project, cannot offer any legal advice. Participants may wish to consult an attorney for any legal advice.

Interview Agreement

Video recordings, audio recordings, and transcripts resulting from the Archive of Modern American Warfare's Oral History Project interviews become part of the Archive of Modern American Warfare at Texas Tech University. This material will be made available to scholars, students, and the general public. Availability will include posting complete transcripts and interview recordings to the Internet for free and open access on the Internet.
